ROLL CALL

On behalf of Board Chairman Bress, who was attending the meeting electronically, Vice-Chair Clark called the meeting to order at 1:55 p.m., and Ms. Deborah Reaves called the roll.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Vice-Chair Clark introduced a motion to approve the April 17, 2016, Board meeting minutes.

Motion #1: To approve the April 17, 2016, Board meeting minutes.

CHAIRMAN'S COMMENTS

Vice-Chair Clark commented on the following topics:

Committee Assignments for 2016

Vice-Chair Clark stated that Board Chairman Bress plans to complete appointments for standing committee Chairs, Vice-Chairs and members by the end of this month. An announcement will be sent out via email toward the end of this month with an updated committee list.

Strategic Planning Initiatives for 2017 and Beyond

As noted previously, meetings will be scheduled in June and September to discuss the Board's strategic objectives. An RFP to engage a facilitator will be released shortly. Trustees will receive information next month regarding the date and agenda for the first meeting.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Executive Director, Eric Stanchfield, commented on the following:

Legislative Issues Related to Procurement and CBE Matters

After many months of discussing the applicability of the Procurement Practices Reform Act (PPRA) of 2010 and the rules related to Certified Business Enterprises (CBE), on May 9, 2016, DCRB's Legal Department received a written memorandum from the District's Office of the Attorney General (OAG) acknowledging that, in their opinion, neither the PPRA, nor the contracting requirements of the Small Local Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Act, apply to DCRB. DCRB Legal will work with D.C. Council staff to draft amendments to properly reflect the application of these laws to DCRB.

Litigation Update and Proposed Legislative Amendments

In *Rivera v. Lew, et al.*, No. 13-5222 (D.D.C. 2016), the US Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit dismissed Mrs. Rivera's appeal for lack of prosecution. Mrs. Rivera had requested Treasury and DCRB accept her posthumous QDRO awarding her a survivor annuity. A formal mandate was issued by the court on May 10, 2016, terminating the appeal.

Following DCRB's recent Council oversight hearings testimony, DCRB's Legal Department has been working with DC Council staff to include technical amendments to the Fiscal Year 2017 Budget Support Act of 2016 (B21-669) related to the DC Spouse Equity Act of 1988 and the procurement law noted above. Updates will be provided as changes occur.

Budget Hearing Testimony Responses

During the April budget oversight hearing testimony, Council Chairman Mendelson asked a few follow-up questions that required responses. Attached for your information is a copy of the questions he asked and the responses DCRB provided on May 12, 2016.

Trustee Handbook

Staff has compiled a Trustee Handbook, which includes the Board Governance Manual and related information and a summary reference sheet to the Open Meetings Act.

INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

The Investment Committee met earlier in the day. Committee Chair Blum noted DCRB's commitments to GEM Realty Fund VI, LP and Level Equity Partners III, LP in the amounts of \$25 million and \$15 million, respectively, recently closed. She also reported that as of April 30, 2016, the Trust Fund was valued at \$6.5 billion.

Committee Chair Blum presented the following proposed motion:

<u>Motion #2:</u> To select a non-discretionary investment consultant for all services, subject to contract negotiations.

BENEFITS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Benefits Committee did not meet this month. On behalf of Committee Chair Smith, Board Vice-Chair Clark reported the following update of activities that occurred since the April Board meeting:

<u>Retirement Modernization Project</u> - <u>Electronic Transmission of HR Data to Treasury's STAR System</u>

A STAR change request is in process that will result in improved retirement processing efficiencies and will pave the way for the faster issuance of an annuitant's first pension check. Implementation of this change will: 1) reduce the amount of manual data entry required to create a new retiree record in Treasury's system, 2) reduce data entry errors that impact benefits computations, and 3) expedite the retirement record creation process. In addition, this step will position DCRB for the installation of its own Pension Information Management System (PIMS).

Benefits Statements

The Benefits Department has begun discussions with Cavanaugh Macdonald (Cavanaugh) related to the development and distribution of benefits statements to active members. To begin this project, the Benefits Department elected to use firefighters as a pilot group, with police and teachers to follow. More information about the project will be provided, including a timeline and completion date, following our next few discussions with Cavanaugh.

Benefits Community of Interest Meeting

The second meeting of the Benefits Community of Interest will be held at DCRB on May 20, 2016. Agenda items are listed in the Benefits Committee Report.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Committee Chair Blanchard noted the following activities of interest since the April Board Meeting.

B21-669, Fiscal Year 2017 Budget Support Act of 2016

Committee Chair Blanchard noted that the District Council met on May 17, 2016, for first vote on the Act and will meet again on the first Tuesday of next month, June 7.
