ROLL CALL

Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

<u>Motion #1</u>: Mr. Lee moved to approve the November 15, 2007 Open Board Meeting minutes, with corrections to the motion approving a change to the economic assumptions, specifically an increase of 0.25% to the actuarially assumed rate of return from 7.25% to 7.5%. Mr. Suter seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 9-0.

GENERAL COUNSEL REPORT

There was no report.

INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

Ms. Blum stated that the Board's lock-out rule, which was provided to the members, will apply to watch listed investment managers.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

Ms. Marcus began by introducing DCRB's Budget Analyst, Sebastian Podesta, who presented the Board's FY 2009 operating budget.

Motion #2: Mr. Lee moved to accept the Operations Committee's recommendation to approve the DCRB fiscal year 2009 operating budget. Mr. Tippett seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 9-0.

BENEFITS COMMITTEE REPORT

Ms. Collins deferred to the General Counsel, Ms. Donovan, to provide the status update on the teacher coding error.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Blanchard deferred to his written report.

OTHER BUSINESS

Greg Stump and Graham Schmidt of EFI presented the 2009 actuarial valuation, including the calculation of the District's contribution for 2009. A brief question and answer exchanged ensued.

<u>Motion #3</u>: Mr. Lee moved to adopt the certified District contribution and the valuation, and to approve the report with the changes reflecting an actuarial rate of return of 7.5% and an inflation rate of 5% pending review by the General Counsel, the Executive Director and the Chairman of the Board, and to poll the Members of the Board and inform them of the results of the changes. The motion was moved by Ms. Dodson and seconded by Mr. Tippett. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 9-0.

The finalists in the actuarial audit firm search made formal presentations to the Board. Brian Murphy and Norm Jones represented Gabriel, Roeder, Smith & Company (GRS) and Douglass Rowe, Steve McElhaney and Ted Goldman represented Mercer. The presentations focused on the methodology that each company would use in conducting the audit, and their experience within the public pension fund sector. A question and answer period followed each presentation.

Motion #4: Mr. Lee moved approval to authorize an actuarial audit of the most current actuarial valuation and experience study performed by EFI (options 1 & 3 in the RFP), and to retain GRS to conduct the actuarial audit, subject to contract negotiations. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 9-0.

<u>Motion #5</u>: Mr. Tippett moved approval to authorize the Executive Director to write to the U.S. Department of Treasury to ascertain the implementation date for provisions of the law which provide for pre-taxing of health benefit premiums for police officers and firefighters. The motion was seconded by Mr. Lee. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 8-0.

Motion #6: Mr. Lee moved to enter into Executive session (D.C. Code §1-909.05(e), (f)). Mr. Ross seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 8-0.
