ROLL CALL

Chairman Ross called the meeting to order at 12:50 p.m. Ms. Deborah Reaves called the roll.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

<u>Motion #1:</u> Chairman Ross made a motion to approve the June 24, 2009, Open Board Meeting minutes as revised. The motion was approved by a voice vote of 8-0.

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Operations Committee Chair, Mr. Clark, made the following motions:

<u>Motion #2</u>: To extend the contract of the Board's actuary, EFI, to June 30, 2010, at a 3% annual increase of the current contract price plus payment for performance of any authorized supplemental services. The motion was approved by a voice vote of 8-0.

<u>Motion #3</u>: To permit qualified voters to cast their ballots telephonically in the 2009 Retired Teacher election. The motion was approved by a voice vote of 8-0.

<u>Motion #4</u>: To adjust the minimum and maximum grade points on the DCRB salary schedule. The motion was approved by a voice vote of 8-0.

INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

The Investment Committee Chair, Ms. Blum, had no action items.

BENEFITS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Benefits Committee Chair, Mr. Suter, deferred to Ms. Passerino for an update.

• The Fall 2009 Newsletter, which is planned for distribution in late October, will cover health care open-season and year-end information for annuitants.

Mr. Tippett asked about the capacity of DCRB's telephone system to record or document incoming calls to the Member Services Center, to count the number of calls, and to provide statistics on response time. Ms. Passerino stated that presently all calls are manually documented and logged. DCRB counts all calls and gathers information on average call times. DCRB's current telephone system does not have the capability to capture the response time for recorded messages. Calls are typically returned within 24 hours, maybe longer if research is needed. She stated that DCRB receives approximately 1,300-1,600 calls per month and there are about 60 walk-ins monthly. Further, customer service surveys are sent out randomly to retirees and DCRB consistently receives a 1.2 rating on a scale from 1 (highest) to 5 (lowest).

Ms. Passerino summarized the proposed structural changes in the Benefits Department due to the completion of the scanning project, which will require retooling of the data technician and file clerk positions.

Ms. Marcus requested an update on the Proof of Life letters. Ms. Passerino stated she would provide this information to Ms. Marcus after the meeting.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

The Legislative Committee Chair, Mr. Blanchard, had no action items.
