ROLL CALL

Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 1:08 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

<u>Motion #1</u>: Ms. Collins moved approval of the February 21, 2008 Open Board Meeting minutes. Mr. Suter seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 11-0.

Motion #2: Ms. Collins moved approval to go out of order of the regular Board agenda. Ms. Blum seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of 11-0.

GENERAL COUNSEL REPORT

Ms. Donovan reported that she was a speaker on a panel entitled "Critical Investor Issues and Negotiations" at a conference on hedge fund due diligence in New York City sponsored by West Legalworks. She also reported that DCRB is coming to closure on investment vehicles on Macquarie Infrastructure Partners II, Babcock & Brown Infrastructure Fund North America, and Warburg Pincus Private Equity X. DCRB's Portfolio Monitoring Agreement with Pantheon Ventures will be amended to include the monitoring of Warburg Pincus Private Equity X. Ms. Donovan noted that on April 21 the IRS's Tax Exempt and Government Entities Division will be having a roundtable discussion with governmental plan sponsors regarding complying with tax qualification requirements.

INVESTMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

The Investment Committee Chair, Barbara Blum, made the following motions:

Motion #3: To approve the following policy: In the event that the Board has not entered into a contractual relationship with a traditional investment manager, excluding alternative investments, that has been selected by the Board within four months after such selection, and due diligence, the Board staff shall report that delay to the Investment Committee which may decide to rescind such selection provided there is no just cause for the delay. Ms. Collins seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of (11-0).

<u>Motion #4</u>: To select Loomis, Sayles & Company, NWQ Investment Management, and Soundshore Management as final candidates of the Board's large cap value equity investment manager search. Mr. Warren seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of (11-0).

Motion #5: To invest up to an additional \$100 million in the Bridgewater Pure Alpha Fund. Ms. Collins seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of (10-1).

Motion #6: To consider and perform further due diligence on the two finalists in the Board's fund to fund manager search. Ms. Collins seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of (10-1).

<u>Motion #7</u>: To allow Pantheon Ventures rather than Watson Wyatt to serve as the Board's fiduciary for the Board's investment in Warburg Pincus Private Equity X. Ms. Collins seconded the motion. The motion was passed with a voice vote of (11-0).

OPERATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Operations Committee Chair, Judith Marcus, introduced Ms. Ong and Mr. Lucas of Thompson, Cobb, Bazilio and Associates (TCBA). Mr. Lucas and Ms. Ong presented the findings of the annual audit of the financial statements of the Teachers' Retirement Fund and the Police Officers and Firefighters' Retirement Fund. TCBA has issued unqualified opinions on both Plans.

No action items were recommended by the Committee.

BENEFITS COMMITTEE REPORT

The Benefits Committee Chair, Mary Collins, provided an update of the scanning and workflow project. She also reviewed the accomplishments of the Benefits Committee and DCRB staff on moving forward with the planned projects that will enhance the operations of Benefits Administration.

No action items were recommended by the Committee.

LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE REPORT

Mr. Blanchard referred to the written report, which highlighted the City Council's passage of the Alternative Retirement Incentive Emergency and Temporary Acts of 2008 and the proposed Iran Divestment legislation. He informed the Board that the public hearing on the proposed Iran Divestment legislation is in May 2008.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Mr. Stanchfield provided updates on recent key projects:

- the document scanning and imaging process has begun;
- the fiber optic project has been completed;
- the actuarial audit is on schedule;
- the classification and compensation study is on schedule; and
- the outside legal counsel search is on schedule.

He welcomed Terrell White, who has joined DCRB's financial team as its Controller.
