THE ACTIVE POLICE OFFICER MEMBER OF THE BOARD**

The District of Columbia Retirement Board (the "Board") is required to conduct elections for its active and retired member representatives to the Board. *See* D.C. Code §1-711(b)(2) (2001). In accordance with the Board's Rules for the Election of Members to the Board ("Election Rules"), the Board, through the True Ballot Incorporated ("True Ballot Inc."), conducted an election for the representative of the active District of Columbia police officers.

The ballots were counted on Tuesday, December 14, 2010, at the Board's office located at 900 7th Street, N.W., 2nd Floor, Washington, D.C., in the presence of Board representatives, and under the supervision of True Ballot Inc.

True Ballot Inc. submitted the Certification of Results to the Board on December 16, 2010. Pursuant section 408.1 of the Election Rules, the Board hereby certifies the election results and declares the winner to be Darrick O. Ross, an active District of Columbia police officer.

Pursuant to section 408.4 of the Election Rules, any qualified election candidate may submit to the Board a written petition requesting vote recount within seven (7) calendar days of this publication of the certification of the winner. In the absence of a written request for a recount, section 408.10 of the Election Rules provides that the election results will become final and cannot be appealed thirty (30) days after the publication of the Board's certification.
