## CERTIFICATION OF WINNER OF THE ELECTION TO SERVE AS THE RETIRED TEACHER MEMBER OF THE BOARD

The District of Columbia Retirement Board ("Board") is required to conduct elections for its active and retired member representatives to the Board. <u>See</u>, D.C. Code §1-711(b) (2006). In accordance with Chapters I-IV of Title 7 DCMR ("Election Rules"), the Board, through the American Arbitration Association ("A.A.A."), conducted an election for the representatives of the retired District of Columbia public school teachers.

A.A.A. submitted the Certification of Results to the Board on December 11, 2009. Pursuant to 7 DCMR §408 of the Election Rules, the Board hereby certifies the election results and declares the winner to be Judith C. Marcus, a retired teacher from the District of Columbia public schools.

Pursuant to 7 DCMR §408.4 of the Election Rules, any qualified election candidate may submit to the Board a written petition requesting a vote recount within seven (7) calendar days of this publication of the certification of the winner. In the absence of a written request for a recount, the election results will become final and cannot be appealed thirty (30) days after the publication of the Board's certification.
